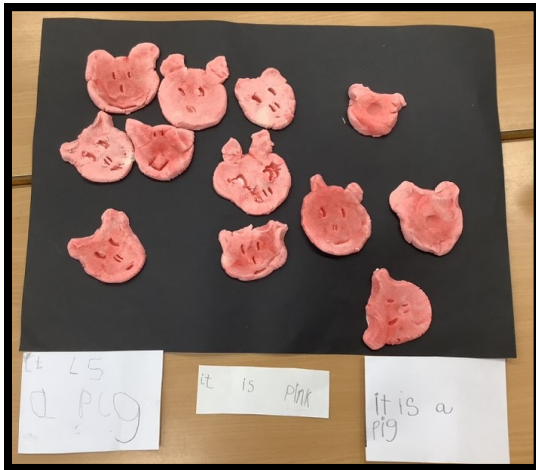

## Reception Little Pigs

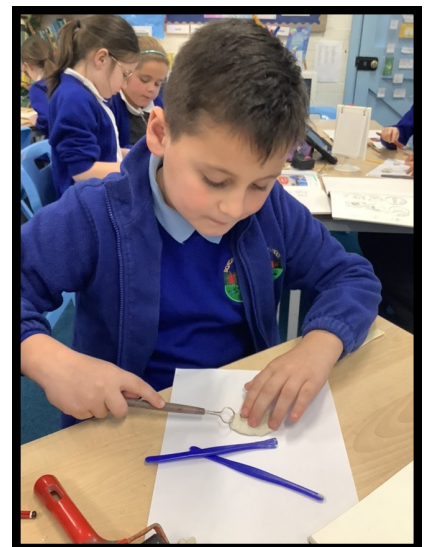


The children in Reception have been looking at the story of The Three Little Pigs. They have made salt dough pig faces and written a label for them.
