Safer Internet Day is celebrated globally in February each year to promote the safe and positive use of digital technology for children and young people, and to inspire a national conversation about using technology responsibly, respectfully, critically, and creatively. We marked Safer Internet Day 2022 on Tuesday and explored the theme 'All fun and games? Exploring respect and relationships online'. Children in Years 2 to 6 considered various scenarios that might occur online and talked about whether or not messages that could be sent to one another online were respectful to others and would make a situation better or worse. They also talked about the importance of telling an adult if something online upset them.
