Defibrillator

We were pleased to welcome The Connor Saunders Foundation to school this week. They have presented the school with a defibrillator as part of their "Keep Sussex Heart Safe" campaign. They shared Connor's story with Owl Class. Owl Class and Fox Class were also able to take part in a first aid workshop. Owl Class would like to fundraise for the foundation and we will share their plans for this soon. The Defibrillator is located just inside the entrance to school and can be used on adults or children and doesn't require any medical



training to operate. We hope we never need to use it, but are very grateful to The Foundation for it.

Warm Weather

Just a reminder as the weather changes to send your child into school with a water bottle and a named sun hat. We have sun cream dispensers in school which contain a hypoallergenic factor 50 sun cream which the children can apply themselves during the day. Please don't send in any sun creams from home for children to reapply, as other children may be allergic to the ingredients. We encourage the children to drink regularly and top up their water bottles. On hot days we regulate how long the children are out in the sun for and often have designated parts of playtime and lunchtime spent in the shade. We may also reduce the amount of time spent outside for PE lessons.

We are in the middle of finalising plans for our Sports Day event. This will take place on the afternoon of Thursday 7th July, with a reserve date of Wednesday 13th July. There will be refreshments for sale at the end of the sports, including cake and ice lollies. We will also have a raffle; prizes include tickets for Revival.
