Dear Parents and Carers,

World Book Day - World Book day takes place on Thursday 7th March. We have decided this year that rather than dressing up for the day, we will take a different approach to celebrating books and reading. The children will all be given a paper plate next week to turn either into a book character or decorate in the theme of a particular book. The teachers will be sharing their ideas with the children at the start of next week to inspire them and give them some ideas. There will be book token prizes for some of the best designs - based on age and ability.

After School Clubs We will be starting a new ball skills and drills club in a couple of weeks time. This club will be aimed at the children in Fox Class initially and opened up to Owl Class if there are spaces. This club is being run by two students from the local secondary school as part of their work towards a nationally recognised qualification and will be supervised by Mrs Dommett. Mr Rogers has plans for more sports clubs in the summer term, including a club aimed at Year 1 and 2. We will share more details later this term.

Squirrel wooden gate - As part of our efforts to support the children with their independence and self-care, we do ask that parents of children in squirrel drop their children at the wooden gate rather than coming to the door of the classroom please. We understand that occasionally you may need to speak to the teacher in the morning and so the fewer parents that go through the gate the easier it is for those that really do need to speak to Mrs Whittle or Mrs Pendle. Messages can also be passed through Mrs Dommett at the gate or Mrs Sheehan in the office.

Mobile phones - You may have heard in the news this week that there is new guidance for schools on children using mobile phones in school. There is no change for us at Boxgrove. We don't allow children to use mobile phones in school. If children bring in phones because they walk to and from school without parents, or for another reason, we do ask that they hand them into the office for safe keeping during the day.
