Our verse for the week is Matthew 7:12 “So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you”



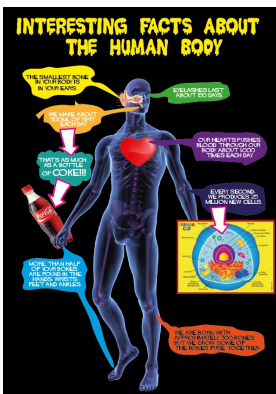
Remembrance Day

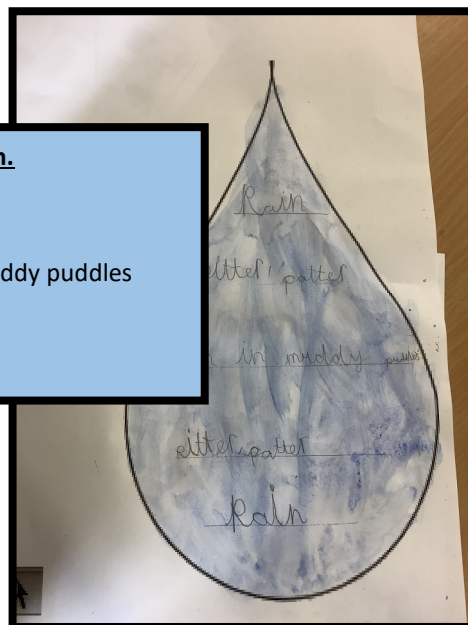
The drizzle didn't stop us getting together outside to celebrate in school. Well done to:



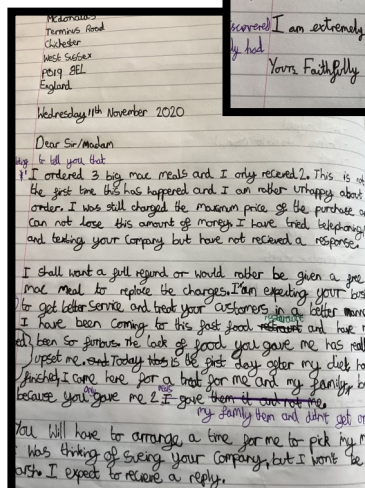
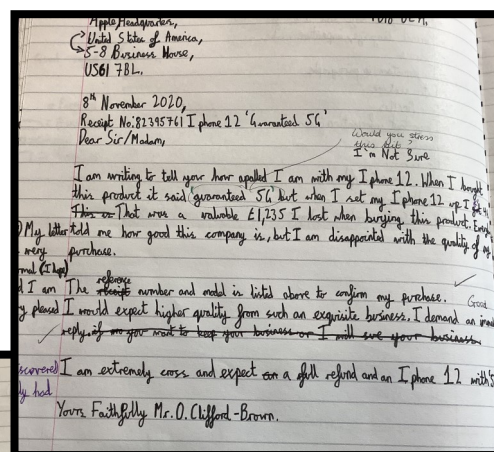
