<u>Thank you</u> - thank you to all the family and friends who were able to join us at Church this afternoon to celebrate harvest. Thank you also for all your donations which we will make sure reach Stonepillow and will make a difference to their work with the homeless.

<u>Starting or transferring school</u> - a reminder that you can now apply for reception places for September 2023. Our Open Days are taking place on <u>Wednesday 9th and Thursday 17th November</u>.
