Choose a minimum of 2 activities for this term. (At least one activity from each row).

Make sure your homework is to a high standard. *Remember to challenge yourself.* Show me just what you can achieve!

<p>Attract birds to your garden by making them a delicious bird cake. Combine melted suet with seeds, nuts and dried fruit. There are lots of recipes online. Bring in the recipe to show us and record which birds are attracted to the cake in your garden.</p>	<p>Use dough or clay to make a replica of your favourite minibeast. Be able to share its features and characteristics with the class.</p>	<p>Find out about which flowers and herbs attract minibeasts. Perhaps you could create a survey of some of the plants in your garden, or the park or countryside near you.</p> <p>Think carefully about how you will present your results.</p>	<p>Make your own set of Top Trumps Minibeast cards. Think carefully about the categories you want to include. You will need at least 10 different cards in order to be able to play the game with a partner.</p>	<p>Create your own Beastie board game. Choose either wild beasts or minibeasts as the theme. Your classmates will be able to have a go playing your game. Lots of fun can be had!</p>
<p>If you could be an insect for a day, what kind would you be? Why? Where would you live? How safe would you be from predators?</p>	<p>Make a comparison between two minibeasts. How are they similar? How are they different? Explain and show these similarities and differences in an interesting way.</p>	<p>Consider a wild beast that you have not studied in school, and produce either a story about them, or a factfile about them. Make it eye-catching and engaging for others.</p>	<p>Make a Beast Creator glossary to explain all the specialist vocabulary associated with this topic. You could include wild beasts and minibeasts.</p>	<p>Read the novel "Charlotte's Web" by E.B White. Write a book review to share with your class. It is a classic children's story. What do you think of it?</p>
