Welcome back to the summer term! Hopefully, it won't be long before it's warm and sunny each day! <u>New Time for the start of the School Day</u> — Thank you for the effort you have all made to be at school for our new start time of 8.45am. Starting the day well has a positive impact on the rest of the day for your child.

<u>SATS, Phonic Screening and Multiplication tests</u> - This term is a busy one, especially with two bank holidays and various national assessments for the children. The Year 6 SATS take place from Tuesday 9th May (the day after the Coronation Bank Holiday) and the children complete a different paper each morning. Our Year 2 children complete their SATs across May, they are delivered in a less formal way than the Year 6 tests and often the children are not aware that they have been tak-ing tests. The Year 4 children complete the Multiplication check at the start of June, after the bank holiday and the Year 1 phonic screening check takes place in the week beginning 12th June.

<u>ParentPay and School Meals</u> Thank you to all the parents who have signed up to ParentPay. The system is now live for you to order meals for your child from the 15th May. Until this date, please order in the normal way. The last date to order meals for your child for the week beginning 15th May is 4th May.

<u>Squirrel Class fitness competition</u>—Before half term, Squirrel class worked really hard on a variety of fitness activities. For a little bit of fun, we turned this into an intra-school house teams competition where children's scores were totalled and then averaged giving us a first, second and third. I can proudly announce that all the children worked really hard to beat their own scores. In third place were Red Team, in second place was Blue team and in first place was Yellow team. Congratulations Yellow team!

Government to send test emergency alert this Sunday

Everyone in the UK will receive a test on their mobile phone of a new Emergency Alerts system on Sunday (23 April). The test Emergency Alert will be a loud, siren-like sound with a message sent to your mobile phone at 3pm. The new system will enable people to be contacted via their mobile phone in the event of emergencies where there is a danger to life nearby, such as severe flooding. Only central government and the emergency services will be able to send them. You can opt out of receiving them if you are in a vulnerable situation. Emergency alerts on your phone will not replace local news, radio, television or social media.
