Dear Parents and Carers,

Our first zoom parents evening went well with only a few minor technical issues! If you haven't signed up for an appointment, there are still a few times available. Zoom links and the list of appointment times will be emailed on Wednesday morning. Thank you for all your feedback to the teachers about how school has worked this term. Like you, the teachers miss being able to catch up at the start and the end of the day. We hope we manage to share as much as we can, given the difficulties of social distancing and facemasks etc. If you have questions, do speak to Mrs Dommett at the gate. If she can't answer your question, she will find out the answer and make sure someone gets back to you.

Knowing the result as soon as you know is really important for us too.
