### **Anti bullying Week**

Learning to understand and manage conflict is an important part of growing up. Bullying is not simply a 'falling out'. Research shows that experiencing bullying can have a significant impact on a child's life well into adulthood. To ensure we are able to prevent bullying, act quickly when it takes place and avoid misidentifying bullying, it is vital that schools and other settings have a shared definition of bullying. This should be understood by the whole school or setting including parents, young people and all staff. At Boxgrove we use the Anti-bullying Alliance agreed shared definition:

The repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power. Bullying can be physical, verbal or psychological. It can happen face-to-face or online.

The children have spent time during anti-bulling week thinking about this and how it links to our Brilliant Boxgrove Behaviours - especially Being Kind. Sophia created a message about bullying that she wanted to share during our Celebration Worship
