We will remember them



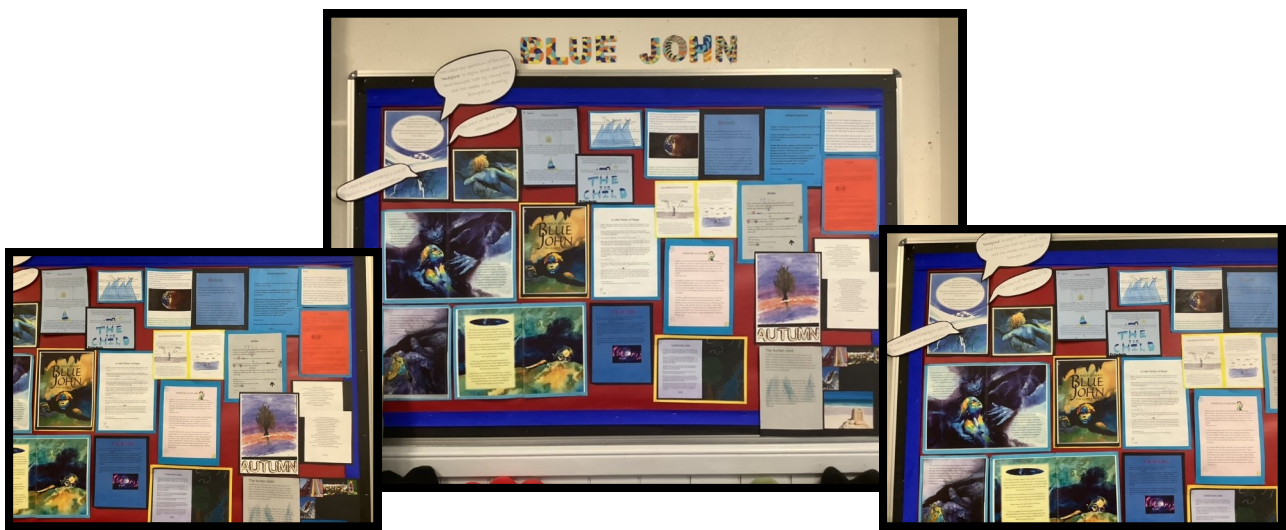
Advent Calendar Collection
