The final payment for the Owl class residential to Cobnor is due next Friday please.

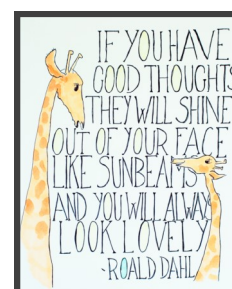
