## Harvest thank you

#### **Cake Sale**

## Whole School Walk

We will go on our walk unless the weather is very heavy rain, so it is important that your child is dressed appropriately with a change for afterwards.

## School PE tracksuit.

Thanks to all of those who have answered the questionnaire, your feedback has been really helpful. When we return after half term, we will be asking children in Fox and Owl Class to come to school in their PE kit. The options will be

- Current school PE kit of royal blue shorts and yellow t Shirt, school jumper, cardigan or fleece, trainers suitable for PE
- A school branded tracksuit with the yellow T shirt
- Part of the school branded tracksuit and current PE kit
- Plain unbranded navy tracksuit bottoms, jogging trousers, yellow T shirt and school tracksuit top or school jumper, cardigan or fleece.

The tracksuit will be available to buy from Game, Set and Match. They have a small number in stock, otherwise they will be available to order.

We have made the decision not to include Squirrel Class in this as they are the children who need most practice at dressing themselves independently and changing at school gives the best opportunity to practice this. As most of our PE lessons take place outside, they can wear the school PE tracksuit on cold days or plain navy tracksuit or jogging bottoms. The tracksuit will be available to buy as separate items, so you can choose to buy the top, bottoms, or neither.
