Dear Parents and Carers,

If your child develops Coronavirus symptoms during the 48 hours after the end of term

Email the school on head@boxgrove.w-sussex.sch.uk.

Arrange for a COVID test

Notify us of the result - negative or positive using the email addresses as above.

If there is a positive case, we will notify the parents whose children have been in contact. If you are notified that your child has been in contact with a positive case they will need to isolate. Please ensure that you check your emails in case we need to notify you.

If your child develops symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, you do not need to contact us. You should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

If your child comes into contact with a positive case during the holidays and has to isolate at the start of next term, please email the school on office@boxgrove.w-sussex.sch.uk or via telephone at the start of the term.

Our summer term restarts on Monday 19th April and we hope as the summer term progresses that some of the restrictions we have had to make in school can be eased. We will continue to be guided by the government guidance and advice.
